

RULES AND REGULATIONS

The goal of the Glenn County Sheriff's Posse Junior Rodeo Saddle Series is to provide a fun and learning experience that the contestants and their families will enjoy.

The Glenn County Sheriff's Posse follows a loose tradition of the current rules set forth by the California High School Rodeo Association. Our particular rules are as follows:

Age determined as of January 1, 2009.

All contestants must wear western hats, pants, boots, and long sleeve shirts.

Contestants caught with or drinking alcohol or using drugs will be disqualified.

Contestants or parents are not allowed to talk to the judge unless requested by the judge.

All ties for points or money will be split by the tying contestants while allowing the G.C.S.P. judge the final decision.

Entry forms must be accompanied by fees.

Parent or legal guardian must sign the release.

There will be a 60 second time limit on all calf, steer & goat events for 6 to 9 and 10 to 13 age groups. 14 to 18 time limit will be 30 seconds.

Goat tying contestants may use a "piggin" string or goat tying string.

Pole bending course will be the same as current high school pattern.

Steer daubing time will be stopped when contestant raises dauber above their head.

Roping:

- Contestants are allowed two loops, except in team roping where three loops are allowed
- Contestants may either rebuild their loop or carry a second loop
- In the team roping the paying contestant solely receives points and they may choose their partner regardless of age
- The barrier will be approximately 2 panel lengths

I, the undersigned, do hereby release Glenn County Sheriff's Posse Inc., and any and all persons associated with the above Rodeo from all liabilities, losses, or damages or liability of any sort arising out of or in any way relating to rider or property. If the participant is minor, the undersigned parent or legal guardian acknowledges that they have read this agreement and agrees to be bound by its terms as a releasor and as a guarantor and indemnity of said persons and/or organizations and their agents, members, officers and directors, for the minor and in the minors place and stead. I waive all rights which I now or may have by virtue of section 1542 of the State of California Civil Code which reads: "A general release does not extend to the claims which a creditor does not know or suspect to exist in his favor at the time of executing the release, which if known by him must have materially affected by settlement with the debtor." I also give my permission to the doctor on duty at the nearest hospital to administer necessary treatment for injuries he or she may have incurred while participating in the above event.
